



## Monitoring and Evaluation in Kindergarten 2011

In KG, we are constantly monitoring and evaluating how our eco 7 steps are progressing. Every class has two Eco Ambassadors and more eco friends and they help the children keep the environment clean and behaving responsibly to the eco environment.

We are lead by an eco leader and a trainee eco leader.

Students keep their classes tidy by monitoring their waste.



Every week the eco ambassadors check the classes to ensure that lights are switched off when no one is in the class, the a/c is off if the windows are open and that students are recycling into the right bins. If they are they get a smiley face on their class tracking chart. The class with the most smiley faces every week gets to keep the GO4Greenie – our eco mascot!!





An eco ambassadors job is never done. If it s not checking the classes are being eco friendly or that the KITAC eco patrols are happening every day or telling the class about the importance of reducing water, electricity and waste, then it is attending our monthly meetings. We invite our eco moms to the class to come and have our meetings too so that they can tell their friends why it is important to be eco.



We had to teach all the new students the eco rules. The students need a refresher course on how to shut the window when the a/c is turned or which bins to use for recycling







Who is on KITAC duty today? Every class has KITAC duty from 12:30 to 12:40 following a roster. We check the playground to see if anyone has left litter on the ground and then put it in the right bin.
